The Government has asked all Local Authorities in the UK to publish, in one place, information about the services and provision they expect to be available in their area for children and young people from 0 to 25 who have special educational needs and/or a disability (SEND).

This is known as the 'local offer'

The local offer is a web-based resource for families to use as often as they like throughout their child's development into early adulthood. It covers a whole range of topical information and details on services that may be beneficial to children and families.
