<p><u>1 Merit</u> Complete any of the Superhero/ Topic worksheets for 1 merit.</p>	<p><u>1 Merit</u> Make a list of 6 different Superheroes. Put them in alphabetical order for an extra merit.</p>	<p><u>1 Merit</u> Draw a picture showing your favourite Superhero. Add labels and explain why she or he is your favourite.</p>
<p><u>2 Merits</u> Learn the 2 or 5 times table by heart and say it aloud in front of the class.</p>	<p><u>2 Merits</u> Tell us about your own personal hero and why they are your hero. E.g. Your mam, dad, someone from the T.V or sport.</p>	<p><u>2 Merits</u> If you could have any super power, what would it be? Write about it and be prepared to tell the class.</p>
<p><u>Up to 3 Merits</u> Research a famous Superhero and write a fact file about them. Be prepared to share it with the class.</p>	<p><u>Up to 3 Merits</u> Make a meal fit for a Superhero to give them lots of energy and strength. Label the foods you have chosen on the plate. If you make a real meal, take a photo of it, or draw it.</p>	<p><u>Up to 3 Merits</u> Write 3 word problems about Superheroes for the class to solve. E.g. If Superman saved 10 people one day and 6 people the next day, how many people would he have saved altogether?</p>
<p><u>Up to 4 Merits</u> In History, we are learning about real life Superheroes such as Amelia Earheart, Rosa Park, Edith Cavell and William Wilberforce. Can you research and tell the class some facts about one of them?</p>	<p><u>Up to 4 Merits</u> Create a short story or comic strip that features a Superhero. It could be about a superhero we all know or one you make up!</p>	<p><u>Up to 4 Merits</u> Design and make your own superhero cape, costume or vehicle. Describe how you made it to the class.</p>
