Choose well-known inventions, or more obscure ones!!</p>	<p><u>3 Merits</u> Write a detailed biography about a famous inventor (e.g. Leonardo Da Vinci, Thomas Edison, Tim Berners-Lee).</p>
<p><u>4 Merits</u> Design and make your own invention</p>	<p><u>4 Merits</u> Research and then write about an invention that has made a massive impact on our lives (e.g the internet, electricity, penicillin).</p>	<p><u>4 Merits</u> Design and make a board game with a focus on inventors and inventions.
