<u>1 Merit</u> Create a picture of a winter creature in its' habitat	<u>1 Merit</u> Make a Winter - themed wordsearch with at least 10 words to find. <i>(If you need squared paper, just ask!)</i>	<u>1 Merit</u> Write a shape poem inspired by fireworks or bonfire night.
<u>2 Merits</u> Write a series of Winter Haiku poems. (5 or 6)	<u>2 Merits</u> Design a Festival poster for one of the seasonal festivals (Advent, Christingle, Hannukah, Diwali or Christmas).	<u>2 Merits</u> Write a short Winter adventure story.
<u>3 Merits</u> Write 5 Winter Maths word problems that need to be solved using the four operations, (+, -, x and ÷).	<u>3 Merits</u> Research and produce a fact file about one of the following mountain regions; The Himalayas, The Alps, The Rockies.	<u>3 Merits</u> Create a 10 question quiz about Winter. Make sure you know the answers to your questions!
<u>4 Merits</u> Design a new toy for Christmas and write a set of instructions to explain how it operates. <i>You do not have to make the toy.</i>	<u>4 Merits</u> Create a Winter themed diorama.	<u>4 Merits</u> Research and write about the life of a famous Arctic explorer (e.g. Roald Amundsen, Captain Scott, Ranulph Feinnes)
