(ELG)

Making Relationships

Show sensitivity to others' needs and feelings

Form positive relationships with adults and other children

Managing Feelings and Behaviours

Work as part of a group or class, and understand and follow the rules

Adjust their behaviour to different situations, and take changes of routine in their stride

Self-confidence and awareness

Choose the resources they need for their chosen activities

Say when they do or don't need help

Understanding of the World

(ELG)

People and Communities

Know about similarities and differences between themselves and others

Know about similarities and differences among families, communities and traditions

The World

Talk about the features of their own immediate environment and how environments might vary from one another

Make observations of animals and plants and explain why some things occur, and talk about changes

Expressive Arts and Design

(ELG)

Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques

Experiment with colour, design, texture, form and function

Represent their own ideas, thoughts and feelings through design and technology, art, music, dance, role play and stories

Literacy

Writing (ELG)

Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others
In writing some words are spelt correctly and others are phonetically plausible.

Reading (ELG)

Read some common irregular words

Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read

Communication and Language

(ELG)

Listening and Attention

Give their attention to what others say and respond appropriately, while engaged in another activity

Understanding

Answer 'how' and 'why' questions about their experiences

Answer 'how' and 'why' questions in response to stories or events

Speaking

Develop their own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events

Physical Development

Move confidently in a range of ways, safely negotiating space

Handle equipment and tools effectively, including pencils for writing

Health and Self-care

Talk about ways to keep healthy and safe

Manage their own basic hygiene and personal needs successfully, including dressing and going to the toilet independently

Outdoor Provision

Use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity.

Introduces a storyline or narrative into their play.

Plays alongside other children who are engaged in the same theme.

Plays cooperatively as part of a group to develop and act out a narrative.


