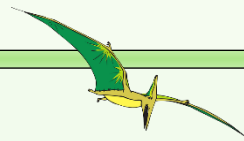

Cold Weather

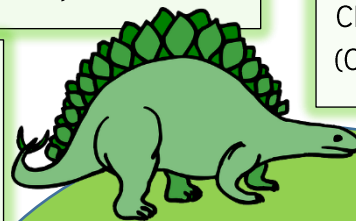
