Phonics

This half term we will be developing our syllable awareness. We will practise our syllable segmentation by clapping and stomping the beats in words and blending them together by finding the missing syllable when given a word.

Literacy

This half term we will be looking at a variety of fiction and non-fiction books relating to our topics. Our activities and experiences will be based around this to help deepen our understanding and develop our love for reading.

Maths

This half term we will be building on our basic skills of Maths. This will be incorporated into our daily activities as well as group work and adult led tasks. We will build upon and develop our knowledge of number, shapes and size.
