Write 3 questions that you would like to ask them.</p>	<p><u>1 Monster point</u> Make a list of the 10 things you would take if you were going on a space mission like Neil Armstrong. Draw and label them in a suitcase.</p>	<p><u>1 Monster point</u> Think of 6 places in the World that you would like to visit or explore- put them in alphabetical order for an extra merit.</p>
<p><u>2 Monster points</u> Create a front cover for a book about either the Moon Landing, Grace Darling's Rescue or another famous historical event.</p>	<p><u>2 Monster points</u> Find out about any planet in Space through research- write own 3 interesting facts about it to share with the class.</p>	<p><u>2 Monster points</u> Learn your number bonds to 100 (it could be tens like 10+90. 20+80 or any 2 digit numbers) and be prepared to answer quick questions on them.</p>
<p><u>3 Monster points</u> Draw an amazing new invention that would help you or your family at home. Add some labels describing the different parts and what they do. It could help in the house, in the garden or outside the home. Use your imagination.</p>	<p><u>3 Monster points</u> Imagine a creature that might live on another planet- draw and label it. Describe its special powers, diet and skills.</p>	<p><u>3 Monster points</u> Explorers draw maps of where they have been- can you draw a map of your bedroom, garden or an imaginary island you have discovered? Remember to add a key explaining the symbols.</p>
<p><u>4 Monster points</u> Write a story or a poem about Space/Life on the Moon/ A space mission. Read it to the class.</p>	<p><u>4 Monster points</u> Have a go at a science experiment, launching a rocket- can you explain what you did and what happened? Do this with an adult please.
