

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Summer 1

Encourage the children to think about how their actions affect others. -How did Jack's actions affect the giant and vice versa.

Encourage children to become increasingly independent when they need things in the classroom e.g. scissors from the creative area etc.

Summer 2

Talk about holidays that we have been on and what we did there.

Share pictures and talk about our favourite parts of the holiday. How can we stay safe on holiday?

Stranger danger, sun smart, water safety.

Talk about what trust is. When have you done something and didn't own up to it? Why is it important to be trustworthy?

Understanding of the World

Geography- What different areas are like around the world? Seas, oceans, corals etc. Locate different places on globes.

Explore plants and living things.

History - Daily timetable – Talking about own experiences . Use past and present seaside photographs to talk about change

Science- How do things change when the weather changes?

(Summer) Explore the natural world around them.

Name at least 5 types of weather. Name at least 3 seasons. Explain how the wind moves objects

Summer 2

Encourage children to explore how to make shades of blue by mixing with different amounts of white paint.

Create 'under the sea' pictures.

Literacy

Summer 1

News writing – what I did in the Easter holidays. What would you like to learn about this topic?

Retell story of Jack and Beanstalk. Use familiar words and pictures. -Write a recount of the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. Hot Seating Jack/Giant/ Jack's Mum. What would they say?

Children to write the journey of a seed. Instruction writing-. How to... plant my sunflower.

Summer 2

Create a booklet about how to stay safe on holiday.

Instructions on how to make ice lollies.

Poster with captions and labels - Why is sun cream important?

Communication and Language

Summer 1

New Topic- what do you know about living things?

What would you like to learn about?

-Encourage children to use Jack and Beanstalk role play area. Encourage use of story language.

-Read a variety of other traditional tales e.g. Cinderella, 3 little pigs etc

Summer 2

Talk about what trust is. When have you done something and didn't own up to it? Why is it important to be trustworthy?

Encourage the children to talk about their favourite sea creature and discuss any sea creatures they may have seen at the beach, in a fish tank or at a zoo or aquarium.
