Making friends
Recognising different emotions.
Following new school routines

Literacy

Reading

Read individual letters by saying the sounds for them.
Blend sounds into words, so that they can read short words made up of known letter-sound correspondences.
Read some letter groups that each represent one sound and say sounds for them.

Writing

Develop listening and speaking skills in a range of contexts.
Aware that writing communicates meaning.
Give meaning to marks they make. Understand that thoughts can be written down.
Write their name copying it from a name card or try to write it from memory.

Composition:

Use talk to link ideas, clarify thinking and feelings. Understands that thoughts and stories can be written down.

Communication and Language

Role-play- Cottage with kitchen
Talk for writing – different endings to the stories, character descriptions etc.
Re-telling using puppets etc to re-tell the stories (T4W)

Listening to & answering questions about different traditional tales
Opportunities to listen to traditional tales without pictures/prompts

Story telling chair- construct our own stories
