Year One Phonic Screening Test

This national test is administered in June. It tests the phonic knowledge of children, their ability to decode and read words, not their understanding. Children who do not reach the required pass mark are re tested the following year. As you can see from the data, the school performed at the National Average for children taking the test at the end of Year One and above the National Average for those who were re-tested at the end of Year Two.

SAT's

In May, each year (with the exceptions of 2021 and 2022), in both Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 are assessed as to whether children are working at Age Related Expectations (ARE). For KS2 this included a scaled score, comparing our school with all schools nationally. Schools used the interim framework to support teacher assessment and tests were used at both KS1 (internally marked) and KS2 (externally marked).
