From the activities in the boxes, you can select which activity to do each week. You are expected to complete one per week, although you can complete more if you wish! Some activities will not take long to complete. Some might need more thinking and research to complete and offer a challenge in how to complete them. You should not complete the same task more than once!

Remember you must know the answers and bring them to class with you.</p>	<p><u>Up to 2 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Log on to ttrackstars and complete 10 minutes to improve your speed! Remember, it shows me how long you were on and when you were on!</p>
<p><u>Up to 3 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Create a poster which explains how to keep our eyes safe and why it is important.</p>	<p><u>Up to 3 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Listen to a piece of music from the time of World War One. Write about how this song makes you feel and how it links to the events of the time. Remember to write down the name of the song and who sings it.</p>	<p><u>Up to 3 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Research the uniform worn by soldiers during World War One. Can you find out what they were made from and why? Find out about the uniforms of soldiers from the UK, the USA and another country of your choice.</p>
<p><u>Up to 4 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Research the countries involved in World War One and the role they played in the key events. Present your information clearly.</p>	<p><u>Up to 4 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Write an acrostic poem with the title REMEMBER linked to World War One and remembrance.</p>	<p><u>Up to 4 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Research traditional food eaten in the UK during World War One and create a menu for a day for a family. Double check your foods are from the UK and not the USA!</p>
<p><u>Up to 5 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Create a symbol of remembrance linked to World War One and explain why you have created this symbol. Your design must link to the war and the events which took place. Remember to design a symbol with respect and care.</p>	<p><u>Up to 5 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Create a model of the eye and label the different parts. Your work must be a model and not a drawing or image of the eye. You can use any materials you wish.</p>	<p><u>Up to 5 Dojo Points</u></p> <p>Talent Showcase – Your chance to share your talent – you could share some art work, a video of you playing an instrument, sporting achievements, baking, craft making etc.</p>
